

Dear Parent / Carer

I am writing to you with details of the upcoming parents' evening for our  $6^{th}$  form students.

The event will take place online on **Thursday 20<sup>h</sup> January, 2021 between 4.30 and 7pm.** The parents' evening offers parents and carers the chance to discuss the progress of their child with subject teachers in 5 minute appointment slots.

Prior to the parents' evening, I encourage all parents / carers to view your child's latest report on Go4schools by visiting <u>www.go4schools.com</u> and logging in as a parent. These were published at the end of last term.

Please also note the following:

- Mr Satchwell is offering appointments on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> January as well as 20<sup>th</sup> January to ensure all students can have an appointment for psychology and sociology. Year 13 appointments are being offered on Jan 20<sup>th</sup> and Year 12 appointments being offered on Jan 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Where multiple teachers are shown for the same subject, appointments can be made with each teacher as they will be discussing different parts of the course (with the exception of Year 12 English Literature.)
- 2 teachers will show for Year 12 English literature, but parents should book 1 appointment only. Surnames A Le should book appointments with Mrs Parsons and surnames Lo Z should book with Mr Edwards.

## About the evening

The online platform we are using is called School Cloud and can be accessed through the web address <u>Paulet.schoolcloud.co.uk</u>, you can join through a smart phone, laptop or computer with a webcam and microphone. Please do have your camera on for the meeting, it is beneficial for our teachers to be able to fully communicate with you during the meeting.

The video is about an example school but all the guidance applies to our website.

All appointments are 5 minutes in length. This enables all parents to have equitable access to teachers. When the 5 minute appointment timer gets to 0, the next appointment automatically starts, meaning the event will last around 15 - 30 minutes in total depending on your child's curriculum.

Please also see the attached help sheet for a step by step guide on booking appointments. The booking system goes live at 4pm on Monday, 10<sup>th</sup> January until midnight on Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> of January.

## Parents who don't live together

Where parents are separated but both parents want to meet the teachers there are 2 options. 1 Parent can invite another parent or relative as a guest and they can join the appointments on their own device from separate locations or both parents can make separate appointments as long as they are listed as priority 1 in our information management system Sims.
